



This bald head china has a brown hair wig similar to prior doll: center part formed by wefted hair strands placed edge to edge, divided again crosswise at back; each section becomes a braid and all three are wound around entire head. There is padding beneath hair above ears. Her handstitched once-white leather body is of much interest, appearing to be original. Note: the long, slender shape of torso and limbs; the tiny feet, seamed at ankle and clear around sole, with stitching to indicate toes; and the flexible knee joints. A former caretaker made certain that the frail leather arms did not lose the well-modeled arms and hands. Thank you to that person, as a complete commercial body of this design is seldom found. The doll has skillfully applied facial features in expected colors of black, blue and red-orange on glazed, very white china; her shoulder head measures $4\frac{3}{8}$ "', overall height is 17". No visible marks.
