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Description

To many collectors the Jumeau doll represents the apex of the dollmaker's art. The Jumeau doll was manufactured in factories near Paris for a century after 1842. What's more, it wore the finest French fashion created by true fashion designers. Rare today, a Jumeau in good condition and in its original clothes commands several thousand dollars at auction.
